## MOTHERS OF SEXUALLY ABUSED CHILDREN SUPPORT GROUPS

Starting Monday, May 1st, we will host a support group for **Mothers of Sexually Abused Children**. The group is a hybrid support group, which meets every Monday from 12:00pm-1:00pm for twelve weeks. Through group therapy, mothers will better understand the impacts of sexual abuse on their children and how to support them through their healing journey. Group therapy will also allow mothers to connect and form a support system to help them navigate their own healing. **The program is capped at 8 participants, so be sure to sign up soon!**
